


The Immaterial Labour Union is a project focused on politically organizing Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and other monopoly social network platforms' workers.









Playbour - the blurrying lines between work and leisure.

e.g: Pleasurable user activities such as updating a status on Facebook or uploading a picture to Instagram become monetised.





EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

Therefore, it is mutually agreed as follows:

Period of Contract:

The period of contract will be 2/3 years commencing from the date of joining in the work. However, on completion of two years of sercice, depanding on the second party's performance, he/she will be eligible for appropriate increment. If the second party's performance is welld ering the contract period, his/her visa will be renewed futher at the discretion of Management.

Probation Period:

Passage:



Medical Facilities:


Medical assistance will be made available to him/her free of cost, in line with the company's rules and regulation.







> **USER PROFILE**: your profile, is your collection of the photos, stories and experiences that tell your story (Facebook)


