Story Memory

A women enters the house.

This are at first undefined scribbles, but maybe it starts to take form as the sticker birds and start to move and try to get in, repeatedly flying against the window.

It are ghostlike forms (embodied by bird shapes, or cat shapes; animal human like creatures) who chase her while she walks through the house.

Only on glass like surfaces these drawings appear. (windows, mirrors, framed paintings the glass in front of the door in the living room) Maybe they interact with the space and with the object she just picked up and looked through.
