"IRANIAN GREEN MOVEMENT" OR "TWITTER REVOLUTION" (2009)

The revolution is an expression of dissatisfaction of the resentful citizens in Teheran towards the ballot-counting progress of the 2009 Iranian Presidential Election. Role of social media in the revolution?

Social media platforms organizing and connecting groups.

"Tunisian Revolution" - Part of the Arab Spring (2010-2011)

President Zine El Abidine Ben Ali ousted, charged, exiled and government overthrown.

Social media at the centre stage in mobilizing the series of street protests.

"EGYPTIAN REVOLUTION" - PART OF THE ARAB SPRING (2011)

President Hosni Mubarak ousted, arrested, charged, and government overthrown.

Egyptian activist tweeted during the protests: "We use Facebook to schedule the protests,

Twitter to coordinate, and YouTube to tell the world."

The advent of social media also provided a tool for women to become protest leaders.
