*Shock Head Soul* is a feature length drama-documentary that dramatizes the life story and private cosmology of Daniel Paul Schreber, the psychotic writer, who was raised within bizarre and punitive systems of training and discipline developed by his father.

Schreber's book Denkwürdigkeiten eines Nervenkranken (Memoirs of My Nervous Illness 1903) was made famous by Freud's critical reading.
